Imagine What God Can Do...To Make Us Sing

Exodus 12:33-15:21

Biblical Observation: We sing because we experience the intimate love of God to calm our fears.

And Moses said to the people, "Fear not, stand firm, and see the salvation of the Lord, which he will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall never see again. The Lord will fight for you, and you have only to be silent."
—Exodus 14:13-14 (ESV)

Song Source #1: We sing because we experience the intimate love of God when He stands with us in order to protect us.

Then the angel of God who was going before the host of Israel moved and went behind them, and the pillar of cloud moved from before them and stood behind them, coming between the host of Egypt and the host of Israel. And there was the cloud and the darkness. And it lit up the night without one coming near the other all night. —Exodus 14:19-20 (ESV)

Song Source #2: We sing because we experience the intimate love of God to breathe power into our circumstances in order to move us forward in trusting Him.

Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and the Lord drove the sea back by a strong east wind all night and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided. And the people of Israel went into the midst of the sea on dry ground, the waters being a wall to them on their right hand and on their left.
—Exodus 14:21-22 (ESV)

Song Source #3: We sing because we experience the intimate love of God when He acts upon the threats to our life in such a manner that we are set free to follow God through His Son, Jesus Christ.

Israel saw the great power that the Lord used against the Egyptians, so the people feared the Lord, and they believed in the Lord and in his servant Moses.
