The Trustworthiness of God
October 3, 2010

Text: Luke 10:21-24

Trust Truth #1: The trustworthiness of God comes from the **consistency** of God's **character** evident in His **presence** and **purity**.

In that same hour he rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children; yes Father, for such was your gracious will." –Luke 10:21 (ESV)

Trust Truth #2: The trustworthiness of God is evident in God's **simplicity** of **focus** demonstrated in His **power** and **provision**.

All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one, knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him. –Luke 10:22 (ESV)

Trust Truth #3: The trustworthiness of God impacts our life through God's **intimate relationship** of **pardoning** and **protecting** His children.

Then turning to the disciples he said privately, "Blessed are the eyes that see what you see! For I tell you that many prophets and kings desired to see what you see, and did not see it, and to hear what you hear, and did not hear it." –Luke 10:23-24 (ESV)
