Embrace Your Inheritance

Matthew 5:5

Biblical Insight: Meekness is not weakness.

And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." –Matthew 28:18-20 (ESV)

Kingdom Embrace #1: Living in relationship with Jesus Christ provides a strength for living which centers us in our core self.

Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth. –Matthew 5:5 (ESV)

When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love you." He said to him, "Feed my lambs." –John 21:15 (ESV)

Kingdom Embrace #2: Living which centers us in our core self develops within us a Holy Spirit controlled response to the things and people around us.

And as they were stoning Stephen, he called out, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." And falling to his knees, he cried out with a loud voice, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them." And when he had said this, he fell asleep. –Acts 7:59-60 (ESV)

Kingdom Embrace #3: Living with a Holy Spirit controlled response allows us to stay focused on God's call for our life.

"For this very night there stood before me an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I worship, and he said, 'Do not be afraid, Paul; you must stand before Caesar. And behold, God has granted you all those who sail with you.' So take heart, men, for I have faith in God that it will be exactly as I have been told." –Acts 27:23-25 (ESV)

Kingdom Inheritance: We inherit the earth when we live in a relationship with God which lets us live beyond the limitations of human strength.

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth. –Acts 1:8 (ESV)
