Focused on the Interruption
February 28, 2010

Text: Matthew 14:29-30

Life Focus #1: Walking on water requires a **relational destination** in Jesus since the power to walk on water comes from Jesus.

And Peter answered him, “Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water.” He said, “Come.” –Matthew 14:28-29a (ESV)

Life Focus #2: Walking on water requires us to **trust** in Jesus over the **circumstances** of the storm around us.

So Peter got out of the boat..... --Matthew 14:29b (ESV)

Life Focus #3: Walking on water requires **faith** in the **new reality** of life in Jesus.

So Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water and came to Jesus. –Matthew 14:29c (ESV)

Life Focus #4: Walking on water requires a **willingness** to **cry out** to Jesus for **help**.

But when he saw the wind, he was afraid, and beginning to sink he cried out, “Lord, save me.” --Matthew 14:30 (ESV)
