Maturity Makeover: Reformed

Text: Psalm 139:13-16

Reformed Concept #1: We are **formed** from the **unformed** so that we are **intimately** known.

For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. –Psalm 139:13-14 (ESV)

Reformed Concept #2: We are **framed** into the **framework** of an **intricate** design so that we are **uniquely** gifted.

My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth. –Psalm 139:15 (ESV)

Reformed Concept #3: We are **freed** to **live** the **story** of our **life** because of His hand upon us.
